

## Spokane Federal Credit Union Eligibility

- employees of the U.S. government who work in or have headquarters in Spokane County
- employees of the U.S. government who work in Ferry, Stevens, Pend Oreille, Lincoln, Whitman, Benton, Franklin, Adams, Columbia, or Garfield County in Washington; in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho; or in Latah or Benewah County in Idaho
- members of the U.S. military stationed at the Navy, Marine and Coast Guard Reserve Center in Spokane, the Mann Hall Army Reserve Center, or the Trentwood Army Reserve Center
- employees and members of the Washington Air National Guard who work in or are headquartered in Spokane County
- employees of the State of Washington who work in or have headquarters in Spokane County
- members of the Washington Army National Guard who work at or come under the control of the Spokane unit of the Washington Army National Guard
- employees of Spokane County and of incorporated cities within Spokane County (except those who are eligible for membership in another occupational-type credit union)
- special tax districts or political subdivisions serviced by the Spokane County Auditor's and/or the Spokane County Prosecutor's office
- employees of the following school districts who work in Spokane County: Central Valley (#356), Cheney (#360), Deer Park (#414), East Valley (#361), Educational Services (#101), Freeman (#358), Great Northern (#321), Liberty (#362), Mead (#354), Medical Lake (#326), Nine Mile (#325), Orchard Prairie (#123), Riverside (#416), and West Valley (#363)
- employees of firms and agencies administratively supervised and under contract with Washington State and Spokane County governmental units and funded through the office of the Spokane County Auditor who work in Spokane County, Washington
- members of Spokane Chapter No. 32 National Association of Retired Federal Employees, who qualify for membership in accordance with its constitution and bylaws as of July 16, 1976
- members of Musician's Association of Spokane Local #105, American Federation of Musicians who qualify for membership in accordance with their constitution and bylaws as of September 28, 1983
- members of the Parish Council and congregation of St. Nicholas Orthodox Church in Spokane, Washington
- employees of and volunteers who work regularly at the American Red Cross, Inland Northwest Chapter in Spokane, Washington.
- employees of McAllister Technical Services who work in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho
- employees of the Broadview Dairy who work in the Spokane operations in the states of Washington and Idaho.

- spouses of persons who died while within the field of membership of the credit union
- employees of the credit union
- persons who live in the following prescribed under-served community: the downtown neighborhood in Spokane, Washington, bounded by the intersection of Boone Avenue and Division on the east and extending south along Division to 8th Avenue, from 8th Avenue west to Washington Street, north on Washington Street to 7th Avenue, west to Cedar Street, north on Cedar Street, west on 6th Avenue to Maple Street, north on Maple Street to Riverside Avenue, east on Riverside Avenue to Monroe Street, north on Monroe Street to Boone Street, and east on Boone to its intersection with Division (this prescribed under-served community meets the investment area definition of Section 1759(3)(c)(2) of the Federal Credit Union Act)
- persons who regularly work, go to school, worship, perform volunteer services, or participate in associations headquartered in the prescribed under-served community
- persons participating in programs to alleviate poverty or distress which are located in the prescribed under-served community
- incorporated and unincorporated organizations located in the prescribed under-served community or maintaining a facility in the prescribed under-served community
- persons retired as pensioners or annuitants from the above employers, members of their immediate families, and organizations of such persons
- the above school districts, all fire protection districts, water districts, and irrigation districts in Spokane County
- full-time, regularly enrolled students of the above-named school districts
