All applicants must submit:

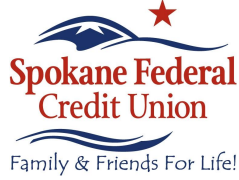
- A completed Spokane Federal scholarship application, essay and two letters of recommendation

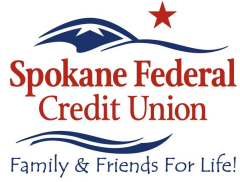

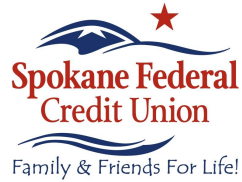
